

Moreover, our law school secured the 4th rank in both the 'Outlook Ranking 2022' and 'India Today Ranking 2022' for top law colleges in India.



ABOUT ASP



Initiated in July 2010, the Academic Support Program (ASP) was designed to enhance peer-to-peer learning at the University. This innovative program serves as a catalyst for improved and simplified understanding of various subjects, utilizing a student-facilitated learning approach and equipping them with essential tools and resources to foster a comprehensive understanding of their academic material.

During its inaugural year, ASP selected eleven diligent students from all academic years (first through fourth) to serve as Student Members to effectively coordinate educational sessions. They collaborated with high-achieving and senior students, who volunteered to mentor their peers, ensuring that these educational gatherings were held outside of regular class times. This arrangement allowed for the successful completion of 50 enriching sessions in its first year, supported by 27 volunteer teaching assistants from various cohorts.

Since its inception in July 2010, the Academic Support Program (ASP) has grown significantly, transforming from a small initiative into a comprehensive support network that reaches a wide spectrum of students. The remarkable growth, conducting more than 100 sessions in each semseter, underscores ASP's dedication to fostering an inclusive academic environment, where peer-to-peer learning thrives, and every student has access to the resources and guidance needed to excel in their studies.

Development of ASP

The Academic Support Program (ASP) at the University proudly upholds its mission as a student-driven initiative, dynamically adapting to meet the evolving needs of its students while steadfastly maintaining its foundational principles and academic integrity. Established nearly 12 years ago, ASP has consistently demonstrated growth and success, reflecting its commitment to academic excellence and collaborative learning.

In the 2022-2023 academic year, ASP notably expanded its reach, involving approximately 60 teaching assistants from the second to fifth years, and successfully conducted 250 sessions. This significant increase in both the number of sessions and participant engagement underscores ASP's dedication to fostering an environment of peer-supported education.

The program also thrived during the challenging times of the pandemic, maintaining a strong academic support network at GNLU. In the 2021-2022 academic year, over 50 teaching assistants and 15 student members and volunteers across various batches facilitated more than 100 sessions. These efforts ensured that the academic culture remained robust and supportive despite external uncertainties. Moreover, ASP now offers concept-clearing sessions throughout the semester and specialized sessions aimed at enhancing performance in exams and other assessments.

Some of those initiatives include the General Semester Orientation Sessions offering students a roadmap to navigate their academic journey effectively, providing insights into study planning, exam preparation, and the relevance of subjects to future career prospects. Meanwhile, the GNLU ASP Mock Examination (GAME) simulates the end-semester exam experience, helping students practice time management and exam strategies in a realistic setting. Through more of such innovative verticals, ASP continues to expand its impact, ensuring that every student receives the support they need to thrive academically.

The collective efforts of team and students helps ASP to continue its process of energizing and serving the academic community with the same passion and commitment that it has always been known for, truly embodying the spirit of student-led collaboration and support.



OUTCOME


Academic Year 2021-2022

The record sheet for the odd semester of the AY 2021-22 showed that the number of sessions conducted was reduced further to 53 sessions compared to the even semester of the AY 2020-21. However, the ASP worked on this setback and successfully managed to deflect it, completing 62 sessions by 7th April in the AY 2021-22 with more sessions scheduled to be conducted in the present academic year.


Academic Year 2022-2023

ACHIEVEMENTS

Intorduction of GAME Initiative

Mock examinations are a valuable tool for students to familiarize themselves with the exam format, identify their strengths and weaknesses, and gain confidence before facing the real test. We introduced the GNLU ASP Mock Examination (GAME) program in the 2022-2023 academic session. This program proved beneficial for the 2027 batch, providing them with a realistic simulation of the end-semester examinations conducted at GNLU. By participating in GAME, students can gain valuable insights into the format, difficulty level, and time management required for success in their actual exams.

Introduction of GROW (General Research Orientation Workshops) Sessions

Research forms the cornerstone of the law school experience. While seemingly straightforward, conducting effective research can be a daunting task. Moreover, strong research skills are essential for crafting publishable legal papers, blogs, and arguments. In recognition of this, the ASP introduced GROW, a program designed to equip students with the tools necessary to excel in legal research. Through GROW, students were able to learn the effective strategies for conducting thorough legal research, develop the ability to critically evaluate and select credible sources for their research projects and refine their research skills, which are invaluable assets throughout their legal careers.

Increasing the size of ASP with intake of more TA's and Batch coordinators

The humble beginning of ASP can be traced back to 2011-12 when GNLU initiated a creative academic programme to help students and get direct guidance from the senior students in the academic field apart from the regular teachings. The programme started with 27 students as teaching assistants. But with the progress of ASP and increasing sessions, more TAs and batch coordinators were included in the ASP family (presently more than 100 members) to conduct smooth functioning of the sessions and redistribution of the increased workload.

More than 200 sessions conducted

Career Opportunity Programme Series (COPS)

Get-Ready with ASP (GRASP)


